Sealing by the Holy Spirit (Eph. 1:13; 4:30)
guarantees our secure delivery to God

Salvation, when the person is fully persuaded-believed in Jesus Christ for the free gift of everlasting life (based on Jesus' death and resurrection) John 3:16; 6:47.

Regeneration of the Holy Spirit (the new birth) Titus 3:5; John 3:3-7

Indwelling of the Holy Spirit as a Permanent possession 1 Cor. 6:19-20; Rom.

Filling of the Holy Spirit seems to be of two different types: 1. A sovereign work of God providing special enablement for specific times (Acts 2:4; 4:8,31; 13:9) 2. The overall character of a person as controlled by the Spirit (Acts 6:3; 13:52) Though commonly used, Eph. 5:18 may well be referring to our human spirit rather than the Holy Spirit. N.B.: Both filling and baptism took place on the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2).

Conviction of the Holy Spirit, John 16:7-11. That faithful ministry which brought us to the point of

At this moment (the time of the Rapture of the Church) the believer is given a glorified body to match his/her spiritual identity

The gradually climbing slotted line represents the spiritual ups & downs of a believer as he/she moves toward spiritual conformity to his/her perfect position in Christ.

The Spirit led Walk (Gal. 5:16) involves allowing the Holy Spirit to be in our lives all He desires to do at any particular point our growing in grace and knowledge. The results is Gal. 5:22,23. Sometimes this is called the "Spirit controlled life." Romans
